

## KENN PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on Monday 4th April 2011 in the Village Hall at 8.00 p.m.

### **Present:**

The minutes of the last Annual Parish Meeting were read and signed.

### **Matters arising:**

Warrens Holiday Village. There has been great progress. Enforcement notices have been issued to some residents and they are being required to pay Council Tax.

Kenn Festival. A very successful Festival was held in June 2010 and £6,000 was raised for charities. The Parish Council had paid £200 for insurance for the event and for the printing of an Historic Houses Trail

Flower Planting. The green as looked beautiful this year. Some plugs of primroses and cowslips will be planted on the green to give flowers at a different time.

### **Financial statement:**

The financial statement was circulated and approved. Its adoption was proposed and seconded

### **Best Kept Village Competition:**

As four of the current Councillors are standing down it was decided to leave it to the next Parish Council to decide whether Kenn will enter in 2011.

### **Royal Wedding:**

Mrs. Naish proposed and Mr. Staples seconded that a Royal Mint Crown should be purchased for every child of school age and under in the parish to commemorate the marriage of Prince William. So far there are to be no other celebrations. The flag will fly and the church bell will be rung.

### **Parish and District Council Elections:**

The term of office of all Parish Councillors and District Councillors comes to an end in May. Mr. Griffin, Mrs. Clark, Mr. Mackay and Mr. Staples announced their intention of standing down. Mr. Griffin was presented with a picture as thanks for his twenty years of service to the village. He thanked fellow Councillors and District Councillors for their help and support.

### **Kenn Business Park:**

There has been difficulty with parking at the Business Park and lorries have sometimes found it impossible to deliver goods. There is some overflow parking. The Clerk said she would attempt to find out from Mike Schneider whether the road had been adopted or not. It was suggested that the Business Management Group got together to see what they could do.
